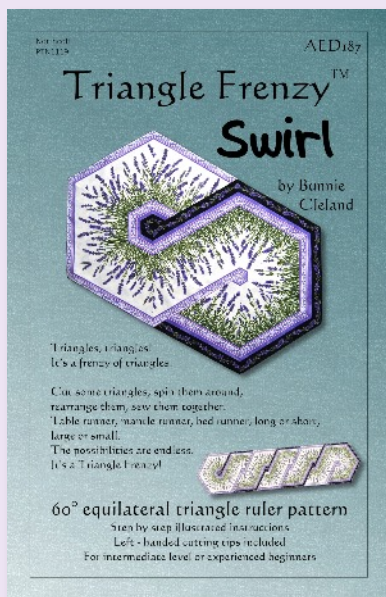


Triangle Frenzy Swirl

You will need:
AED I 87 Triangle Frenzy Swirl Pattern
FQG I 22 Stacking Pop-Up Pattern
FQG I 23 Medium 8" Spring Refill



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FQ-Gypsy-Pop-Up-ideas



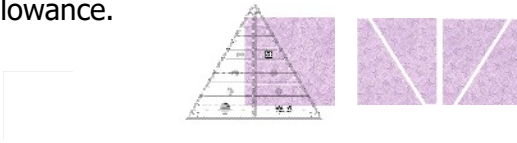

Use these directions as a guideline. Smaller Swirls will require more background fabric. Larger Swirls will wrap around the Pop-Up and may not be entirely visible. When adding fabric above the Swirl, keep at least 1½" of background fabric at the top edge of the Pop-up.

Make one Swirl, modifying the Triangle Frenzy Swirl pattern as follows: At step 3, adjust strip width selection to cut a strip measuring 3" wide x 24" long. After step 13, either applique Swirl onto background fabric, or piece background fabric as follows. Cut two squares of background fabric the same width as the Swirl strip (3" x 3"). (If desired, cut setting triangles larger and trim to size after sewing.)



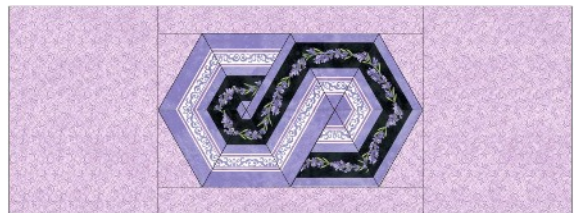
Place the two squares wrong sides together. Using triangle ruler, cut half triangles as shown, at least ¼" away from each end to allow room for seam allowance.



Sew setting triangles to the ends of the Swirl.

Trim all four edges so that setting triangles are even with Swirl, making sure to keep ¼" seam allowance on sides.

Top 3 ½" x 9", Bottom 1 ½" x 9", Sides (2) pieces 10" x 10"
Add top, bottom and side pieces around Swirl.



Final Size: 9-1/2" x 26-1/2"

To make the pop-up, replace 'Outer Fabric rectangle' in Cutting Instructions with pieced outer fabric section.

Apply Stabilizer after piecing blocks and strips together. Trim to size.

Assemble Pop-Up using FQG122 Stacking Pop-Up pattern

Cut Ties/Loops from Inside Fabric.

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
