

Change to pattern: This applies to all patterns with a version (found on back cover under logo) of V0619 or earlier. I am increasing the length of the Top Band and Stabilizer pieces to make it easier to get the tote on the frame. Please use the following dimensions instead of those in the printed pattern. The top band will be slightly larger than the tote to accommodate the thickness of the foam. Page 10: Pin at corners, then centers and ease/stretch the band to fit.


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Page 10: I added measuring and marking the body to determine where to stitch the box corners in case of shrinkage of foam if a lot of steam is used while fusing.

Box Corners

17. Find the center (C) of each side. Mark stitching locations (B) for each boxed corner. Measure distance according to the chart below from the center of each long or short side to the locations to mark. Mark on either Lining or Outside.

	Short Side	Long Side
Bread Tray	3"	6-3/4"
Casserole	4-3/4"	6-3/4"
Side Dish	4-3/4"	4-3/4"



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
